Education in Action's Lone Star Leadership Academy

Teachers are encouraged to nominate outstanding 5th-8th graders to join delegations of distinguished students from across the state of Texas at the Lone Star Leadership Academy. This weeklong, TEKS-based, experiential leadership development program occurs in Dallas/Fort Worth, Austin or Houston/Galveston during summer break. The Academy provides opportunities for students to experience grade level curriculum during visits to historically, politically, scientifically and environmentally significant sites with a focus on leadership throughout. Participants must be in 5th-8th grade, maintain an 85 or higher average, be active in school and/or community activities and receive an educator recommendation based on demonstrated leadership ability. There is no limit to the number of students an educator may nominate as long as they meet the eligibility requirements.
