

DUAL CREDIT/ARTICULATED COURSE TRANSFER AGREEMENT

TEXARKANA COMMUNITY COLLEGE

&

NORTHEAST TEXAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE

This agreement between **Texarkana Community College** and **Northeast Texas Community College** is to encourage secondary students enrolled in specific dual credit Agriculture classes to continue their education and pursue a college degree or certificate in Agriculture.

Both institutions will share information to ensure all required course information is complete. Dual credit instructors will follow all dual credit procedures and guidelines to ensure college-level instruction to eligible secondary students seeking college credit for competencies developed in high school.

Effective _____ this agreement will need to be renewed annually at which time either party may request a change or termination of this agreement. It is agreed that students who enroll and successfully complete the specified Agriculture course through the Texarkana College Dual Credit Program will be eligible to transfer specified college credits to Northeast Texas Community College towards existing NTCC Agriculture degrees/certificates.

The conditions of the agreement were formulated through communication with representatives from both institutions based on agreement of course content, objectives and learning outcomes. Under this agreement, the following conditions are hereby set forth:

- The Texarkana College dual credit coordinator will initiate an annual review of this agreement with an NTCC representative to evaluate any changes in competencies, content, or standards.
- Texarkana College will be responsible for evaluating instructor credentials to insure they meet all accreditation requirements, including, but not limited to Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) and Southern Association of Colleges, Commission on Colleges (SACS-COC).
- This agreement may be terminated in whole or in part by either party upon annual review. However, such termination shall not effect transfer of student credit previously earned during the period of a signed agreement.

Dual Credit students successfully completing authorized college courses listed in this agreement will have those courses transcribed on a TC college transcript. Students must enroll at NTCC in specified dual credit courses to transfer.

NTCC will continue to offer articulated credit to high school students who complete a dual credit course(s) listed in the agreement under the following guidelines: To receive credit, the student must satisfy the following requirements: Must meet all NTCC admission requirements, must have graduated from high school, must have completed the specified high school course(s), must be currently enrolled at NTCC and have completed at least (12) semester hours of credit, must petition for college credit within five months of high school graduation.
