• Verification of a death (obituary or death certificate) in your immediate family. Immediate family for purposes of a		
 financial aid appeal is parents, siblings, children, spouse or grandparents; or Verification of military orders for military personnel and their families that have been temporarily reassigned or called to 		
 Verification of military orders for military personnel and their families that have been temporarily reassigned or called to active service; or 		
• Verification of natural disasters beyond your control that impacted your academic performance; or		
• Personal tragedies that were beyond your control and are documented by a 3 rd party professional, i.e. police, courts,		
 medical, clergy, etc. If you submit a divorce decree, you must submit additional documents such as a restraining order, child custody papers, 		
or any additional legal documentation. A divorce decree alone is not considered an extenuating circumstance.
