Electrical Technology Certification



"The instructors really let you give your input in and let you ask questions. They're open to explaining things and not just demanding," said Tadd. Once he completes the certificate and obtains a job, Tadd plans to enroll in online or night classes to get his Associate of Applied Science in Electrical Technology.

Anabeth's personal medical history attracted her to scientific research. Since completing classes at TC, she has been able to narrow down what she enjoys and finds interesting in order to help her identify exactly what career to pursue.

"I am looking into biochemical research and epidemiology. My dream job is a biochemist or biochemical researcher and to one day research diseases to figure out a way to control rapid infection. I am transferring to the University of Central Arkansas where I will major in biochemistry to complete my bachelor's," Anabeth said.

"My favorite part of the teaching at TC was the way the instructors used a hands-on method where the lab and lecture line up. For example, you recreate what you learned about in lecture during the lab. Whether it was a small key being electroplated or testing the pH of different foods, allowing the students to interact and learn was key to me being able to learn, retain, and in the end, pass my courses," Anabeth said.





Student Support

ACADEMIC COMMONS

Texarkana College's hub for student support services is the Academic Commons. Located in the heart of campus, the Academic Commons is home to the Palmer Memorial Library, testing center, disability services, tutoring, computer and printing access, a coffee bar, and TRIO academic support and outreach programs. The Academic Commons staff provides free workshops for students to aid in navigating technology, career exploration, engaging with campus clubs and organizations, study tips, and time management.

PALMER MEMORIAL LIBRARY

The Library provides access to books, magazines, scholarly journals, and other materials in print and electronic format as well as instructional programming on how to access and use those resources and supplemental materials to support coursework. Reference and instruction librarians are available to assist students with access and research needs. In addition to instructional programming, the library offers events to support creative and social enrichment such as book clubs and other literary events, craft tables, informational displays, and more.

DISABILITY SERVICES


TC's disability services provides academically qualified TC students who are diagnosed with a physical or learning disability with reasonable academic accommodations to provide equal access to learning on campus. Students in need of disability services should contact TC's director of disability services by calling 903-823-3349 and set up an appointment. From there, a student will need to provide documentation of disability from a health care provider. TC is committed to assisting students with access to learning opportunities.

TRANSFER CENTER & CAREER COACH

The Academic Commons houses the TC Transfer Center to assist students who want to transfer their credit earned at TC to a university to complete a bachelor's degree. Services available include advising, assistance with application completion, and help finding scholarships and other financial aid resources. Students also have access to an online tool to assist with determining a career path and courses that support a pathway toward employment. Career Coach guides students through an assessment of interests and skills and provides detailed information about employment projections and salaries. TUTORING & STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

Texarkana College offers free tutoring for students to support academic coursework. Students can access a math lab for assistance with all levels of math courses, and an English/writing lab to assist with essay assignments, and assistance with most academic courses. The Academic Commons is also home to the federally-funded TRIO programs at TC. Students who are first generation college students or who meet income guidelines may qualify as a participant in the programs. Through this program, students may participate in time management and financial literacy workshops and other enrichment courses to support student success. Students can schedule in-person or online tutoring sessions.





CARE CLOSET AND FOOD PANTRY

For students with special circumstances and unmet needs, the TC Care Closet offers toiletry and essential items as well as childcare items such as diapers, formula, and baby food. Non-perishable food items, canned goods, and packaged lunch items are also available through the TC Food Pantry. COUNSELING SERVICES

TC's on-site licensed professional counselor is available by appointment to assist students with emotional, mental, physical, or behavioral needs. Students can refer themselves or can be referred by faculty or staff members. Paying for College

FINANCIAL AID

All students are encouraged to fill out the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at fafsa.gov to see if they qualify for federal grants, loans, and/or work-study jobs to help pay for college.

Many of our students receive federal Pell grants that pay for most of their education at TC—and grants don't have to be repaid. Now, Pell dollars go further at TC! Year-round Pell grants are available for full-time students who want to continue taking courses in the summer.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The Texarkana College Foundation awards hundreds of scholarships annually to TC students, with an average award of \$1,500. Foundation scholarships are based on a wide variety of criteria set by the donors, including but not limited to financial need, community service, and pathway.

Graduating high school seniors who meet stringent academic criteria may be eligible for the TC Presidential Scholarship, which pays full tuition and fees for up to two years.

Non-traditional and adult learners may qualify for our Just Start Scholarship, which awards \$1,000 per school year.

Additionally there are several program-specific and residency-specific scholarships available each semester.
