Changing Lives

With the support of our generous donors, the Texarkana College Foundation is committed to being a part of the solution. In the last year, **over 6,700 students** passed through Texarkana College. We awarded **over 730 degrees and certificates** for our community's workforce, including nurses, educators, and electricians.

Texarkana College offers 22 academic programs and 12 workforce programs. At an average annual tuition and fee cost of \$2,980 per year, Texarkana College costs **\$6,869 less** than the average 4-year public university in Texas and **\$14,593 less** than the average 4-year private university in Texas.

Texarkana College ranked in the **top 5** of all Texas community colleges for **3-year and 4-year completion rates**. **80%** of our students require financial aid or scholarship support to complete college.
