This program was inspired by data from the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) that shows consistent disparities in completion rates for men of color compared to their female and other male peers. Students in ACTIVATE are in a cohort of 10-12 men that seeks to equip program participants

with the necessary skills to be successful both inside and outside of the classroom with the goal of completion at TC. ACTIVATE is generously funded by the Texas Pioneer Foundation.
